issues this:

DECISION

Amending and completing the Decision of the President of the National Regulatory Authority for Communications and Information Technology no.321/2008 on the allotment and use of national short numbers for European harmonised services

Art.I. – the Decision of the President of the National Regulatory Authority for Communications and Information Technology no.321/2008 on the allotment and use of national short numbers for European harmonised services, published in the Romanian Official Journal, Part I, no.328 of 25 April 2008, shall be amended as follows:

1. Article 28(1), letter c) shall read as follows:

“c) the LURN holder must activate each national number within the 118(xyz) range, as provided by Article 17(2), within 12 months from the date of its allotment and notify ANCOM within 30 days from the activation date;”.

2. Article 31 shall read as follows:

„Art.31. – Starting from 28 November 2009, the providers of publicly available electronic communications services can no longer use other numbers in the PNN than those within the 118(xyz) range, for the provision of directory enquiry services or ancillary services, under the provisions of this decision.”

Art.II. – This decision shall be published in the Romanian Official Journal, Part I.
