

REGULATION ON THE IDENTIFICATION OF RELEVANT MARKETS IN THE ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SECTOR

Third part – IDENTIFICATION OF WHOLESALE MARKETS IN THE ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SECTOR

Art. 1. – (1) On grounds of Part 1 of this regulation, the following relevant markets of the product are identified:

- 1. Market of unconditioned access to the twisted metallic pairs local loop for the purpose of providing broadband data services and voice services;**
- 2. Market of providing leased lines at a local network level,** comprising services for providing leased lines at local level;
- 3. Market of providing access to the electronic communications networks associated facilities,** comprising any facility, including associated resources that have not been created to be used as a support of electronic communications networks, that are used as associated facility for at least one electronic communications network (high and low voltage piles, ducts, trenches, buildings, towers, subway tunnels etc).

(2) The geographical market corresponding to each of the products markets identified at paragraph (1) is the national market determined by the Romanian territory.

Art. 2. – The National Regulatory Authority for Communications shall review the markets identified at art. 1 by adding new markets the features of which may justify the imposing of specific obligations to electronic communications networks or services providers having significant power on these markets, or by modifying the identified markets.

Art.3. – Within the meaning of this Regulation, the terms below are defined as follows:

- a) **access to broadband data services** – access to data services with a bandwidth of minimum 128 Kb/s;
- b) **access to narrow band data services** – access to data services with a bandwidth less than 128Kb/s;
- c) **local network** – a network hierarchically inferior to the digital routers at county level;
- d) **national network (inter-county)** – a network hierarchically superior to the digital routers at county level.

Note:
