Considering the provisions of the *Regulation to conduct market analyses and determining the significant market power*, approved by the Decision no. B/EN/2002 of the president of the National Regulatory Authority for Communications,

issues the present:

DECISION

Art.1. – „Orange Romania” – S.A. is designated as operator with significant power on the market of access to its own mobile telephony network for the purpose of calls termination for voice services.

Art.2. – One or more of the obligations under art. 9-14 of Government Ordinance no. 34/2002 on access to, and interconnection of, electronic communications networks and associated infrastructure, approved with amendments and completions by Law no. 527/2002, shall be imposed to

„Orange Romania” – S.A. through Decision of the president of the National Regulatory Authority for Communications.

Art.3. – This decision shall be communicated to „Orange Romania” – S.A.
