- Legislation in force should be the guardian of the entire selection procedure:
 - European legislation (e.g. Directive 2002/20/CE, Directive 2002/21/CE, Radio Spectrum Decision, RSPP, European Commission Decisions);
 - National legislation;
 - CEPT/ECC Decisions and recommendations;
 - Secondary legislation, if necessary.
- ☐ Consultation mechanism should be present when NRA adopts rules and regulation for the selection procedure.

The consultation mechanism allows to:

- 1. Understand the rules;
- 2. Adjust the rules, if the case;
- 3. Improve the selection procedure;
- Create an open partnership between NRA and market players;
- 5. Active and fruitful participation in the adoption of rules process.

Benefits for:

- Interested party (operators);
- 2. NRA and operators;
- 3. NRA;
- 4. NRA and operators
- 5. NRA and operators.

- ☐ Understanding the rules is the key issue especially when NRA applies a new concept (types of auctions):
 - Comparative selection procedure (tender);
 - Competitive selection procedure (e.g. SMRA, CCA auction).
- Auction design and form of auctions.

■Procedural aspects

- Procedural matters should be discussed with the market players in a transparent manner in order to understand the rules before starting point:
 - ✓ Communication with the Commission;
 - ✓ Transfer of the requested information between bidder and the Commission;
 - ✓ Electronic surveillance (if the case);
 - ✓ Rules of conduct;
 - ✓ Bid submission and bid increment;
 - ✓ Time and completion of a round:
 - **√**

☐ Failure to comply with the procedural aspects will increase the risk:

- Effects:
 - Legal challenge;
 - Litigation;
 - Postpone or cancellation of the selection procedure.

- ☐ Rights and obligations conferred by the licences:
 - License term:
 - ✓ validity;
 - ✓ coverage obligations;
 - ✓ quality of services,
 - ✓ technical conditions;
 - ✓ transfer of the usage rights;
 - ✓ licence amendment and revoking.
 - Measurements and monitoring procedure in ToR or in licence;
 - Access obligations (national roaming and/or MVNO).

- ☐ Legal representation of bidders (power of attorney):
 - Legal representation during the selection procedure;
 - Limits of the power of attorney.


Anti-collusion rules;

- Any attempt to conclude, any agreements between the participants;
- Agreements between the candidates/bidders themselves and the agreements involving members of the groups of different candidates/bidders.


- ☐ Rules relating to the participants conduct:
 - the attempt to influence the members of the Commission;
 - the attempt to contact the members of the Commission (see exceptions).
- ☐ Letter of guarantee:
 - value;
 - form and conditions [e.g. validity (e.g. July 31, 2013) execution).
- □ Payment obligation (licence fees) and conditions should be established before starting point.

- Independence from other applicants (de jure/de facto);
- □ Competition issue (aquisition of the usage rights and limitations);
- ☐ Transitional measures, if the case.
- Specific measures adopted by NRA in case of breaking the rules.
